Instructions for Completing the FedEx Express Prior Notice Form for Transmission to FDA

Complete the FedEx Express PN Transmission Form using this instruction sheet. The data elements required for PN transmission are listed as they appear on the form from left to right. All information provided to FedEx must be correct and complete to minimize shipment delays/refusals due to incomplete or incorrect PN information.

FedEx Express AWB No.: The FedEx air waybill number for the shipment. **Date of Shipment:** The date the shipment is tendered to FedEx. **Country Shipped From:** The country from which the article of food is shipped. **Submitter:** Name and address of individual/company responsible for providing complete and accurate PN data elements. to/through the U.S. Shipper FDA Registration No.: Number assigned by FDA to an individual/company that manufactures, processes, packs, or holds foods. Provide Shipper's Registration No. if shipper is required to register with FDA. If shipper is not required to register with FDA, indicate "Not Required" instead of Registration No. and specify exemption in Remarks. See http://www.cfsan.fda.gov/~furls/cpgreg2.html for applicable registration exemption. This data element is not required for non-U.S. destined shipments transiting the U.S. the same as ultimate consignee/sold-to-party. This data element is not required for non-U.S. destined shipments transiting the U.S. sold-to-party. This data element is not required for non-U.S. destined shipments transiting the U.S. description of each food product in shipments with multiple food items, such as gift baskets, etc. HTS Code: The 6-digit Harmonized Tariff Schedule Code, if available. 100 pallets of 2/100 lb cartons each of dehydrated pig ears for a total of 20,000 lbs. process, and specific distinctive character. Provide this code if available. Lot or Code No.: Lot or Code numbers are the identification numbers or code of a production lot which specifically identifies a product for screening and examination purposes. This number is required for low acid canned foods, acidified foods, and infant formulas. bottle, plastic bag, paper wrapper, cardboard box, metal can, etc. Country of Production (FDA): The country where the article of food was made/processed, if product is no longer in its natural state OR the country where the article of food was grown, if the product is in its natural state. natural state. for articles of food in their natural state. Note: Shipments containing food products from multiple growers require PN for each article of food and must include the grower's information, if known. If growers are unknown and a consolidator is involved, you may provide the consolidator's information. Manufacturer Registration No.: Number assigned by FDA to manufacturers of food products. This number is required for food imported into the US if food is no longer in its natural state. If Registration No. is not available, provide reason code in the Remark field - See http://www.cfsan.fda.gov/~pn/cpgpn4.html for applicable code. This data element is not required for non-U.S. destined shipments transiting the U.S.

Note: Prior Notice for food shipments that fall in the following categories is not necessary:

- 1. Shipments containing 'homemade' or 'store-bought' food products, shipped from <u>one individual</u> (not a business) <u>to another individual</u> (not a business) <u>for personal use</u> (non-business purposes)
- 2. Meat, poultry, and egg products exclusively regulated by the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA)
- 3. Shipments arriving in the USA and directly exported from the Port of Arrival (foreign-to-foreign through one US port)
